

RESOLUTION #24-0723A – A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

WHEREAS, the Village of Ashmore is applying to the State of Illinois for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to continue water infrastructure improvements that were accomplished with Phase I in 2019 and Phase II in 2021, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made and agreements entered into with the State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the grant application process may require special permits and permissions from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency or other agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

SECTION 1:

- 1) that the Village of Ashmore apply for a grant under the terms and conditions of the State of Illinois and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances contained in said application;
- that the Village President and Village Clerk on behalf of the Village shall each be authorized and directed to execute such documents and all other documents necessary for carrying out said application;
- 3) that the Village President and Village Clerk are independently authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant;
- 4) that the Village Superintendent is authorized to petition and acquire such special permits as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.

SECTION 2: The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable, and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect. All resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded. This Resolution is effective immediately upon passage and shall remain in effect until rescinded or superseded by Village.
