Election Calendar

November 25, 2022 Last day to file an objection to a candidate's nomination papers

<u>Included in the Election Packet (available in the Ashmore Municipal Office):</u>

- Receipt for Election Packet documents <u>fill this out immediately and return to the Clerk upon</u> <u>picking up this Election Packet</u>
- Statement of Candidacy
- Petitions for Nomination
 - Candidates must collect at least 6 signatures and not more than 56 signatures
 - Signers must live within the corporate village limits
- Loyalty Oath (optional form)
- Statement of Economic Interest (**must be filed with the County Clerk first**, and they will give you a receipt; include the <u>receipt</u> with the packet paperwork.)
- Code of Fair Campaign Practices

November 18 8:00am-5:00pm

All of the Candidate's original nominating papers, or "packet," must be filed with the Ashmore Village Clerk at the Municipal Office during the designated filing period. Candidate names will appear on the ballot in the order that completed packets are received by the Clerk. If multiple packets are received at 8:00am on November 12, then a lottery will be held on Tuesday, November 19th at 8:30am to determine the ballot order. Anyone may attend to witness the lottery. Packets received by mail will be deemed to have arrived at 8:00am of the date received.
