

UNCONDITIONAL AND FULL GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY WAIVER DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE

This is a legally-binding UNCONDITIONAL AND FULL GENERAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER, DISCHARGE AND CONVENANT NOT TO SUE made by me,

(hereinafter referred to as Operator) to Village of Ashmore and its Board of Trustees, (hereinafter referred to as Village).

I fully recognize that there are dangers and risks to which I may be exposed by operating a non-highway vehicle on Village streets. The following is a description and/or examples of significant dangers and risks associated with this activity:

- 1. Injury to myself or others,
- 2. Damage to my property or that of others,
- 3. Death of myself or others.

In NO event shall the Village be liable for direct, indirect, special, incidental or consequential damages, whether arising in tort, contract, or any other legal theory, in connection with or arising out of operator's use of a non-highway vehicle on Village streets.

The operator, as of the date below, shall hereinafter save, hold harmless and indemnify the Village against any and all liability, claims, causes of action, and costs of whatsoever kind and nature including, without being limited to injury damage, loss including death, resulting from, arising out of, or occurring in connection with the use of this non-highway vehicle on Village streets.

I understand that the Village has Ordinance 062612A governing the use of non-highway vehicles on Village streets and hereby agree to conform to all the requirements of the village Ordinance at all times. I have had the opportunity to read said Ordinance and my signature below acknowledges that I will comply with this Ordinance and all of the applicable traffic laws of the State of Illinois at all times when operating this non-highway vehicle on Village streets.

I, therefore, agree to assume and take on myself all of the risks and responsibilities in any way associated with this activity. In consideration of and return for the opportunity to operate a non-highway vehicle on Village streets do hereby release the Village, Board of Trustees, Employees and Agents from any and all liability, claims and actions that may arise from injury or harm to me or others, including death, or from damage to my property or property of any other in connection with this activity. I understand that this release covers liability, claims and actions caused entirely or in part by any acts or failures to act on my part, including but not limited to negligence, mistake, or failure to act on my part, including but not limited to negligence, supervise or maintain.

I assure the Village that there are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude or restrict my participation in this activity. I further assure the Village that I have adequate health and liability insurance necessary to provide for and pay any medical costs or property damage that may directly or indirectly result from my participation in this activity, and I will indemnify and hold the Village harmless for any such medical costs or property damage.

I understand that this Release means I am giving up, among other things, rights to sue the Village, its Board of Trustees, employees, and/or agents for injuries (including death), damages, or losses I may incur or cause. I also understand that this Release binds my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, as well as myself.

COMPARING ASHMORE, KANSAS, OAKLAND, & WESTFIELD NHV ORDINANCES

The Village of Ashmore has made an agreement with the City of Oakland, with the Village of Kansas, and with the Village of Westfield that allows Ashmore residents to obtain a permit in Ashmore, and then that permit is valid in all three towns. This means that your Ashmore permit will allow you to operate your Non-Highway Vehicle (or "NHV") in Kansas AND in Oakland AND in Westfield. Kansas, Oakland and Westfield permits will also be honored in Ashmore. (Kansas, Oakland and Westfield do not honor each other's permits at this time.)

Whatever town you are in, you must still obey all the ordinances for that town. With that in mind, we have created this chart to help you understand what is permitted or forbidden for each municipality. This is meant to be a quick-reference guide or summary for your convenience.
